

ROOSEVELT COUNTY

Roosevelt County is Montana's 19th most populous county, with a population of 10,425 according to the 2010 Census. Wolf Point, the county seat, is the state's 28th largest city, with a population of 2,621 in 2010.¹ Other cities and towns in Roosevelt County include Bainville, Brockton, Culbertson, Froid, McCabe, and Poplar. The vast majority of Roosevelt County, including Wolf Point, lies within the Fort Peck Indian Reservation.

Montola Growers in Culbertson produces oilseed products and provides a reliable market for local crops by providing participating farmers with certified, proprietary seed and guaranteeing 100% crop buyback.²

Roosevelt County also boasts Assiniboine Village, a 40-acre site on the banks of the Missouri River, where visitors experience traditional Assiniboine culture through music, dance, food, games, and storytelling.³







(In 2010 Dollars)




