Theme: Make Plans Level: Next Steps

# At a Glance

Students use CIS Financial Aid Sort and create a list of scholarships for further investigation.

Time: 50 minutes.

## **Essential Questions**

- What scholarships best match me?
- How do I manage the scholarship application process?

### Preparation

- Secure computer lab with overhead projector enabled and CIS access
- Make copies of Securing Financial Aid Awards Worksheet, one per student.

### Steps

- 1. Show PowerPoint (PPT) Slide 1. Tell students that the goal of this lesson is for each of them to create a list of scholarships that match their preferences for further exploration.
- 2. Show PPT Slide 2. Ask students "Have you thought about applying for scholarships yet? Allow students to share what they have done so far.
- 3. Tell students, "You are more likely to get scholarships if you have a program of study (degree) plan in mind. This plan can change but many scholarships are associated with a specific field or program of study. This activity will you find scholarships that match you and your goals." Distribute the Securing Financial Aid Worksheets.
- 4. Show PPT Slide 3. Review the instruction for completing the worksheet on page 1 of the worksheet.
- 5. Show students where to find Financial Aid Sort in CIS (Under the Education Tab).
- 6. Demonstrate Financial Aid Sort in CIS.
- 7. Provide students 15 minutes to use Financial Aid Sort.
- 8. Ask students to share their results by asking how many scholarships were on their lists, and if they found some appropriate possibilities.
- 9. Tell students to save their results and place a star next to any scholarships of high interest.
- 10. Show Slide 4. Ask students to complete the Award Tracking Table on page 2 of the worksheet. Provide ten minutes for this activity. Explain that staying organized using this table will be crucial during the busy fall of senior year.
- 11. Remind students that the school counseling staff and their families can provide important support during this demanding time.
- 12. Walk around the room and assist students as they create their tracking tables.
- 13. Show PPT Slide 5. Ask students to share their next steps for scholarship application.

# Variations and Accommodations

- Put students who need extra assistance in pairs while completing these activities.
- Financial Aid Sort could be completed with a teacher, advisor, or family member outside of class and then Award Tracking Tables drafted and reviewed in class.
- A school counselor could come to class and lead this activity.
