


## **Workforce Size in Cascade County**

# Top Employing Industries, 2023




Percent of Total Employment

Cascade County has had about the **same** number move in as out since 2020.


**6.3**% of workers in Cascade County **work from home**, below the statewide average of 10.6%.


### Population by Age Group and Participation in Labor Force
