


Workforce Size in Flathead County

Top Employing Industries, 2023




Percent of Total Employment

Labor Force Participation

62.6% of Flathead County's population over 15 participates in the labor force, close to the statewide rate of 63.0%.

85.1% of Flathead County's prime working age population (25 to 54 years old) participates in the labor force, above the statewide rate of 84.2%.

Rapid Population Growth in Flathead County


Flathead County had **10,800 more people move in** than out from 2020 to 2023, the most in the state.


13.7% of workers in Flathead County **work from home**, greater than the statewide average of 10.6%.






Population by Age Group and Participation in Labor Force
