


#### **Workforce Size in Silver Bow County**

#### Top Employing Industries, 2023




Percent of Total Employment

**60.1%** of Silver Bow County's population over 15 participates in the labor force, below the statewide rate of 63.0%.


**79.5%** of Silver Bow County's prime working age population (25 to 54 years old) participates in the labor force, below the statewide rate of 84.2%.

**6.4%** of workers in Silver Bow County **work from home**, below the statewide average of 10.6%.


## Net Migration as a Percent of the Population by County


#### Population by Age Group and Participation in Labor Force
