


Workforce Size in Treasure County

Labor Force Participation

64.4% of Treasure County's population over 15 participates in the labor force, similar to the statewide rate of 63.0%.


79% of Treasure County's prime working age population (25 to 54 years old) participates in the labor force, below the statewide rate of 84.2%.

Treasure County had the same number of people move in as out from 2020 to 2023.


22.2% of workers in Treasure County **work from home**, above the statewide average of 10.6%.


Population by Age Group and Participation in Labor Force
